This project will be a major & vital Arts project, which will include - design & delivery of two painted metal silos within the township of ST ARNAUD. Ridley organisation have given permission for the ST ARNAUD ArtSpace & local Artist - "Kylie Torney" to paint their silos with murals.

The project will welcome community input in design, working with the ArtSpace & the Artist. Community will be involved in marketing & final say in design.

The community benefits of this large project will be vast with long term major Tourism draw-card benefits. It will create further employment opportunities in Hospitality, Retail & Tourism, not just for ST ARNAUD, but also surrounding towns.
