Project Details

A summary of what the project is, including where it is

1. An indication of the objectives of the project, what the planned outcomes are and how they can be measured

To provide drought assistance for farmers in the St Arnaud district. The objectives are to provide both financial and physical support.

This grant application is for "Pamper Packs" to be delivered to drought affected farmers. The packs will contain make-up, perfume, soaps, hair treatments, after shave, razor blades for example. Donations of goods from pharmaceutical suppliers, wholesalers and retailers will be supplemented by purchased items, such as perfume.

2. An explanation of how the community will benefit

There will be about one hundred farmers receiving this benefit. The objective is to help with the well-being of the whole family.

3. An estimation of how many people will benefit

We plan to provide the food deliveries to one hundred farmers. The "pamper pack" will be included in one of these deliveries, early in the year.

4. What contribution/in kind support your organisation will make towards the project

The St Arnaud Rotary Club is coordinating the whole effort, including working with other service organisations. We will seek donations from many of these items will be sought as donations from the pharmaceutical retailers, suppliers and wholesalers.

5. Who will manage the project

6. What the overall cost of the project is

The overall cost will be \$124 000 total

This is made up of:

- \$4 000 from the Coonoer Bridge Wind Farm
- Possibility of \$10 000 from North Balwyn Rotary Club
- Food from Foodbank sourced through the St Arnaud Community Resource Centre

7. What the timeline of the project is
