We would like to stop this environmental impact and purchase crockery and cutlery for 100 and glassware for a lesser number-3 dozen, to be utilized instead of plastic items.</p>

Yeungroon Hall Committee Inc, intend to purchase a set of hospitality industry quality crockery, cutlery and glassware items from Caterworx, Bendigo. We wish for the set of items to include, 100 dinner plates (\$6.40), 100 side plates (\$2.50) that can also be utilised for smaller afternoon tea events and meetings, and 100 multipurpose soup/dessert bowls (\$5.05).

The crockery set would comprise of 9 dozen each of Table forks (\$10.60 per dozen) and knives (\$15.80 per dozen); soup spoons (\$9.70 per dozen); and dessert spoons (\$9.60 per dozen).

Glassware items would be 3 dozen each of water glasses (\$2.20) and multi-use wine glasses (\$3.20).

Additionally, 4 water jugs and 4 large platters.

We have liaised with the Yeungroon CFA Brigade and these items can be housed at their facility which is completely vermin proof and secure and where the majority of the Yeungroon Hall Committee Inc. gatherings occur now. They have also offered to purchase the items on our behalf if an ABN is required.

We have been aware of the environmental impact that continually using non-recyclable plastic items causes and endeavored at our most recent function in October to cease the practice by hiring the required items. This was both expensive and time consuming with arranging collection and return of the many boxes of crockery and cutlery required. We would like these items to be assets of the many future Yeungroon generations. Our committee have a limited amount of funds that could be utilised to purchase replacement items due to breakage and the accompanying items to complete a catering set, such as coffee cups and teaspoons.

The project would be managed by Secretary Fran Lanyon and could be completed including a media article acknowledging the generosity of Coonoor Bridge Wind Farm within 6 weeks of receipt of grant funds.
